



2008 Jersey Wahoos/Parkland Dual Meet at Jersey Wahoos November 8-9, 2008



Lauren Belecanech, 10, swam a strong meet racing to 1st place finishes in her 100 IM, 50 and 100 backstroke events. Lauren shaved her seedtime in nearly every event. **Nicholas Belecanech, 10**, stroked his way to 1st place finishes in his 50 and 100 breaststroke and fly swims. **Duncan Brookover, 10**, picked up two new A time standards in his 50 and 100 breaststroke swims. Duncan raced to 2nd place finishes in his 50 back, 50 and 100 breaststroke swims. **Breann Cavanagh, 10**, raced to a five second time drop in her 200 breaststroke she also sliced time in her 100 free and 100 breaststroke swims. **Saylor Cook, 10**, touched the wall 3rd in her 100 free and 50 fly swims. She had personal bests in her 100 fly and 50 free swims. **Abby Czerniecki, 12**, raced to 5th place finishes in both her 50 free and 100 IM swims. **Mary Kate Davis, 12**, raced to a personal best in her 200 free and a 4th place finish in her 200 backstroke. **Anthony Di Carlo, 10**, raced to an A time standard in his 50 fly. Anthony touched the wall 3rd in all his swims, with a personal best in his 100 back. **Paige Dunham, 12**, raced to 3rd place finishes in her 100 back, 50 and 100 fly swims. Paige touched the wall 2nd in her 100 IM.

Sean Finias, 10, shaved time in his 50 and 100 breaststroke. Sean finished 3rd or better in all his swims. **Brian Finnan, 10**, raced to personal bests in three of his four swims. Brian dropped time in his lead off split of the 200 free relay. **David Finnan, 12**, raced to a 4th place finish in his 50 free and 5th in his 100 breaststroke. **Rosa Johnson, 12**, swam a strong 200 breaststroke shaving her seedtime by more than nine seconds, touching the wall 2nd. She also sliced more than five seconds from her 100 breaststroke, to finish 3rd. Rosa picked up double A times in her breaststroke events. **Lauren Kerner, 9**, stroked her way to a nearly five second time drop in her 200 free posting an A time standard. She also sliced her seedtime in the 50 and 100 free. Lauren raced to double A times in her 50 and 100 freestyle swims. **Michael Kurtz, 12**, shaved time in his 50 fly (30.98) touching the wall 1st and he also shaved his 100 fly (1:11.17) down to a new A time standard. **Peter Kurtz, 12**, raced to a personal best and a 2nd place finish in the 100 breaststroke. He also shaved time and finished 3rd in his 50 free. Peter raced to a new BB time standard in his 200 breaststroke and an A time standard in his 100back. **Emily Lund, 10**, powered her way to the wall in all her swims. **Alex Martin, 11**, touched the wall 1st in his 50 free with a time of 27.61. He chopped more than forty seconds from his 200 freestyle, finishing 5th. Alex brought home a new BB time in his 200 free and an A time standard in his 50 fly. **Matt McGough, 10**, stroked his way to 1st place finishes in his 200 IM, 200 free and 50 free. Matt swam to personal bests in his 200 IM, 100 fly and 50 free events. **Sarah McGough, 10**, stroked her way to a new A time standard in her 100 breaststroke. She touched the wall 2nd in both of her breaststroke events.

Carlos Obregon, 10, shaved his time in the lead off spot of the 200 medley relay. He shaved even more time in his individual 50 back to finish 2nd with a new A time standard. Carlos finished 2nd in his 100 and 200 freestyle swims. **Isabel Obregon, 10**, sliced time in her freestyle events. She raced to a 2nd place finish in her 200 freestyle. She also sliced time and picked up a new AA time in her 100 fly. **Elizabeth Olson, 10**, touched the wall 3rd in her 200 free shaving more than two seconds from her seedtime. She raced to 3rd place finishes in both her breaststroke events. **Timmy Proctor, 10**, touched the wall 1st in his 100 free, 50 and 100 backstroke swims. Timmy shaved time in his 100 free. **Nicole Shek, 10**, swam a strong meet slicing her seedtime in three of her four swims. She touched the wall 1st in both her breaststroke events. **Steven Shek, 11**, swam another great meet shaving time in all his swims. He touched the wall 1st in his 100 fly and 100 IM events. He raced to four new A time standards in his 200 free, 100 fly, 100 and 200 breaststroke swims. **Kyle Shurmur, 12**, stroked his way to a 2nd place finish in his 200 backstroke. He was 3rd in his breaststroke swims. **Natalie Simunek, 12**, raced to a new A time standard in her 200 freestyle. Natalie touched the wall 3rd in her 100 IM. **Bryisia Vizard, 12**, raced to an eleven second time drop in her 200 breaststroke, to finish 4th, she also placed 4th in her 100 breaststroke.

Kyra Adamson, 16, competed in the 200 free and 500 free events and finished with an AA in the 200 and an AAA time in the 500 free. **Matthew Belecanech, 16**, finished first in all his events posting a Top 16 time in the 200 free and 100 back events. He also raced to AAAA times in all his other events, the 200 back, 400 IM, 500 Free, and 200 IM. **Bobby Bendzyn, 15**, competed in 5 events finishing with an AA time in the 500 free, A times in both the 400 IM and 200 fly and BB times in the 200 Breast and 100 breast events. **Danny Bennett, 16**, improved in both his events by dropping a few tenths and posting BB times in the 200 and 100 breaststroke events.

Emily Bennett, 14, had a good meet improving in 4 events. She dropped almost a second in her 200 free to post an A time, almost 3 seconds in her 100 fly to post a BB time, and almost 2 seconds in her 100 back to post another BB time. She also dropped time in her 50 back by leading off a relay. She also raced to an A time in the 400 IM and 500 free events. **Elise Blaschke, 18**, competed in 6 events placing first in the 200 IM, and second in the 200 and 100 breast and 50 and 100 free events. She finished with four AAA and two AA times. **Patrick Bryan, 18**, raced to first place in the 200 back, 400 IM and 200 fly events. He dropped time in both his 50 back and 50 free as lead off in the relays. Pat finished with four AA and two A times. **Owen Burns, 15**, had a good meet improving over 4 seconds in his 500 free and over 2 seconds in his 200 fly, while posting AAA times in both events. He also posted an AAA time in the 100 fly and won the event.

Chris Campbell, 15, dropped almost 2 seconds in his 50 back leading off a relay. **Emma Carpenter, 15**, won the 100 and 200 breast events posting AA times in both. She also swam the 200 IM to an AA time and the 100 fly to a BB time. **Johnny Carroll, 14**, swam a perfect meet improving in all 7 of his events. He won the 200 breast improving almost 4 seconds and the 100 breast by dropping .35 of a second. He also improved over 4 ½ seconds in his 200 free, over 3 seconds in his 400 IM, over a second in his 500 free, almost 3 seconds in his 200 IM, and over ½ of a second in his 50 free as the lead swimmer in the relay. Johnny finished with 4 AAA and 3 AA times. **Alex Charbeneau, 15**, swam to AA times in both the 200 and 100 back events and dropped time in her 50 back as the lead off swimmer in a relay.

Gianna Constantine, 15, raced to an A time in the 50 free as the lead off swimmer in a relay. **Scott Dennis, 15**, improved in both of his events dropping over a second in his 100 fly and ¼ of a second in his 50 free. **John DiCarlo, 17**, raced to A times in the 50 and 100 free and also competed in the 100 and 200 fly and 100 and 200 back events. John scored in the 100 fly with a 3rd place finish. **Lauren Faykes, 18**, raced to first place in the 100 back posting an AA time. Lauran also posted AA times in the 100 free, 200 back, 50 free and 200 IM events as well as an AAA time in the 200 free event.

Colleen Finias, 14, competed in the 200 and 100 breast events improving ¼ of a second in her 200 breast. She posted A times in both breaststroke events as well as an A time in the 50 free as the lead off swimmer in the relay. **Colin Fisher, 13**, had a great meet improving in 5 out of 7 events. Colin dropped over 5 seconds in his 200 fly, over ½ a second in his 200 free, 100 fly and 200 IM events, and ¼ of a second in his 400 IM. He finished with 1 AA time in the 200 free, 4 A times, 1 BB time, and 1 B time. **Andrew Fleisher, 14**, won the 100 fly by improving over a second and a half and posting an A time in the event. He also posted A times in the 100 and 200 back and 200 and 400 IM events. **Thomas Glenn, 16**, raced to a perfect meet improving in all 4 of his events as well as winning the 200 fly and posting a AAA time in the event. He dropped over 2 seconds in both his 100 and 200 back events as well as ¼ of a second in his 100 fly. Tommy finished up with the 1 AAA time, 1 AA and 2 A times.

Nicole Jibrine, 15, tied for first in the 100 fly and finished the meet with 6 AA times in the 100 and 200 fly, 100 and 200 back, and 200 and 400 IM events. **Krissy Katsigiannis, 17**, raced in 3 events, the 100 and 200 breast and 500 free events posting all BB times. **Catherine Kolaski, 16**, swam to 4 AA times in the 50, 100, 200 and 500 free events. **Katie Kurtz, 13**, improved in 2 events by dropping over 3 seconds in her 200 back to post an AAA time in the event and almost a second and a half in her 200 IM to post a AA time in the event. Katie also posted a AAA time by winning the 100 back event. Other AAA times were in the 100 free and 100 fly events and other AA times were in the 200 IM and 50 free events.

Bryan Lembo, 17, raced to an A time and second place in the 100 breaststroke event. He also finished with BB times in the 200 breast and 50 and 100 free. **Madison Leonard, 14**, competed in 4 events posting A times in the 200 and 500 free and BB times in the 100 and 200 fly events. **Annie McCotter, 14**, improved her 200 free by dropping almost 2 ½ seconds and posting an AAAA time in the event. She also improved in her 200 IM posting a

AAA time. Annie won the 200 fly and placed 2nd in her 200 back event. She finished with one AAAA time and five AAA times. **Maureen McCotter, 16**, raced to three first place finishes in the 100 and 200 back and 200 fly events. She finished with five AAA times and one AA time.

Meghan Miceli, 15, raced in the 100 and 200 breast posting AA times in both. Meghan also finished third place in both events. **Allyson Mitidieri, 16**, swam in both the 100 and 200 breast and 200 IM events. She finished with AA times in the 100 breast and 200 IM and an A time in the 200 breast event. **Taylor Moore, 17**, competed in 5 events finishing with an AA time in her 400 IM and four A times in the 200 and 500 free as well as the 100 and 200 back events. **Patrick Olson, 15**, had a stellar performance improving in 2 events and finishing first in 3 events. Pat improved almost ½ of a second in both his 50 and 100 free and placed first in the 50 free and 100 and 200 breast events. Pat posted one AAA time in the 100 free and five AA times.

Courtney Patterson, 14, improved in 2 events by dropping over 5 ½ seconds in her 200 breast and almost a second in her 200 free. She achieved a AAA time in her 200 free and finished the meet with one AAA time, four AA and one A time. **Leigh Anne Patterson, 17**, competed in 6 events placing first in the 400 IM and second in the 200 free, 100 fly, and 500 free events. Leigh Anne finished with three AAA and three AA times. **Grant Proctor, 13**, raced in 3 events and improved almost 4 seconds in his 200 back. Grant finished with 3 BB times in the 100 and 200 breast and 200 back events. **Ryan Richards, 13**, had a great meeting dropping time in 5 events. He improved over 7 seconds in his 200 back, almost 5 seconds in his 500 free, over 2 seconds in his 100 back, almost 2 seconds in his 50 back as the lead off swimmer in the relay and a tenth of a second in his 50 free. Ryan finished with three AA times, 2 A times, one BB and one B time.

Chris Schlitt, 17, raced to a near perfect meet improving in 5 out of 6 of his events. Chris dropped over 4 ½ seconds in his 500 free, over 3 seconds in his 200 free, over 1 ½ seconds in his 400 IM and over ½ a second in both his 100 back and 100 breast. Chris posted A times in both the 200 and 500 free events. **Andy Schuehler, 13**, had a perfect meet dropping time in all 4 of his events and finishing with two AA and two BB times. AA times came in his breast events with over a 5 ½ second drop in his 200 breast and almost 2 seconds in his 100 breast. He also improved over 6 ½ seconds in his 200 fly and over ½ a second in his 100 fly. **Ford Scott, 14**, had a perfect meet improving in all 4 of his events and posting AA times in all four as well. Ford dropped over 2 ½ seconds in his 500 free, over 1 ½ seconds in his 200 free, and also a tenth in both his 50 and 100 free. Ford also placed 2nd in both the 50 and 100 free. **Katie Scott, 17**, raced to 4 BB times in the 100 and 200 fly and 100 and 200 breast events. Katie improved in her 200 breast by dropping over a second.

Jessica Simunek, 17, competed in 6 events placing 1st in the 100 fly and second in both the 100 back and 200 fly events. Jessica improved over ½ a second in her 200 back to post an A time in the event. She also finished the meet with 5 AA times. **Alexandra Smith, 14**, raced to a good meet improving in 3 events and posting two A and three BB times. Alex dropped over ½ a second in both her 100 breast and 50 free as well as improved in her 200 breast. Alex's A times were in the 100 and 50 free. **Amy Stelmaszyk, 15**, raced in 5 events posting AA times in all 5 of them and scoring in the 50 free with a 3rd place finish. **Dana Stone, 15**, led off a 200 free relay and improved her 50 free by almost two tenths.

Nicholas Turner, 13, swam one event, the 100 back, and improved his time posting a BB time. **Bobby Waldner, 16**, raced in five events, scored in both the 50 and 100 free and posted three AA and two A times. Bobby also improved a tenth in his 100 free. **Courtney Wallace, 16**, lead off a medley relay with a great swim in the 50 back. **Stephanie Yaszemski, 16**, competed in the 50 and 100 free, scoring points in the 50. She posted AA times in both events. **Jenna Zagoren, 13**, raced in four events, posting AA times in all of them and improving two tenths of a second in her 100 free. Jenna also scored points placing 3rd in the 100 back.
